

NFRA Board Policy Terms for Reference for Honorary Board Members November 15, 2010

The NFRA by-laws allow for the election of non-voting honorary Board members for 1-year terms. These terms can be renewed on an annual basis.

Honorary Board Members complement the skills and interests of formal Board, provide a way to create or strengthen relationships with community leaders and partners, and provides a source of outside advice and recommendations to the Board.

Terms of Reference for Honorary Board Members. Honorary Board members agree to:

- Serving one-year, non-voting term (no-term limit);
- Being invited to all formal functions of the NFRA Board (i.e., calls, meetings, etc) but are not obligated to participate;
- Participate in at least one conference call with the NFRA Executive Committee to be briefed on the business and activities of NFRA;
- Provide advice and recommendations to Board as appropriate:
- Be available for informal conversations; and
- Agree to support the mission and goals of NFRA.
